

Shadows and lights are part of our everyday life and evoke a spectrum of metaphors: hiding, feeling safe, being oppressed, speaking up and showing our truth. Gender-based violence can also be hidden, not sometimes obvious, sometimes acknowledged.

In this international training we research together how to create safer and braver spaces for creative dialogue about gender-based violence. We open an error-friendly space where we can share our struggles, needs, utopias and open questions. And learn from each other's perspectives and feminisms.

Using contemporary shadow theatre and forum theatre, we research and weave together our stories as well as our joint learnings to one aesthetic piece. In the final performance we invite the audience to intervene on stage, change the story and discover together how we can build healthier relationships.

We invite all queer and all feminist people who are living in Austria and want to engage creatively against gender-based violence. People with and without theatre experience are welcome.
